People Power

NLEC Day Center for Women and Children

In 2016 New Life Evangelistic Center opened the only major downtown day center that is exclusively reserved for homeless women and children. Daily the homeless at this day center receive meals, spiritual help, shower, fellowship and special assistance from NLEC's case manager.



Overland Expansion

In 2016 NLEC administrative and renewable energy offices moved into the facility at 2428 Woodson Road in Overland. During 2016 five Energy Fairs were held at this location.

Beyond Hopeless

In 2016 the number of homeless individuals receiving assistance at the NLEC Springfield Veteran's Coming Home Center jumped from an average of 150 to over 200 homeless people served daily. This day center is now the largest in the Springfield, MO.
